

Continuing the established tradition — to record events and help the museum, on 14 May 2005 the photo campaign Object: Right Bank — Left Bank takes place. More than fifty Latvian photographers responded to the invitation to have a ride on a boat and to capture in pictures both banks of the Daugava from Dole Island to the entry of the river into the sea.

Architecture creates silhouettes and the city gradually changes also from the distance. A silhouette as a lifeline of the city. Houses, open spaces, towers and bridges. Everything that can be seen on the right and left riverbanks of the Daugava becomes an object of the photo campaign.

Being crammed in the same conditions, on a single boat, the photographers are challenged to show their personal and individual vision of what they see on the riverbanks. The planned construction on both banks — the new concert hall on AB Dam, the Contemporary Arts Museum in Andrejsala, highrises in Ķīpsala and Lucavsala — makes the process of image taking historical.

More than 30 photographers take part in the campaign. Both riverbanks framed in the pictures of Latvian photographers are displayed at the exhibition in the Latvian Museum of Architecture on 16 November — 21 December, but later along with films they are presented to the Latvian Museum of Architecture and remain in its archives.
